

**INFORMATION LEAFLET – SCIENTIFIC LITERATURE PROGRAMME****Who can apply?**

Former one-year scholarship holders as well as former German studies scholarship holders (who received support for a period of at least 5 months) from developing countries and from Eastern and Southeastern European countries (Romania, Bulgaria, Commonwealth of Independent States - CIS) **and who returned from Germany to their home country** can apply once a year for scientific books and journals to help them advance their academic knowledge.

**Not eligible** to apply are former scholarship holders from **all** members of the European Union.

**Application Deadline**

Applications can be placed **once a year only** (from January 1<sup>st</sup> until October 31<sup>st</sup>). Please note that longer delivery times must be expected.

**Type and Extent of Support**

- 1) Scientific literature up to a maximum value of € 200 can be applied for **once a year**.
- 2) Grants can only be approved for scientific books and journals produced by German-language publishers.
- 3) In the case of subscriptions for scientific journals, approval will initially be granted for a period of one year, which can be extended once this period comes to an end.  
**The subscriber is responsible for renewing the application.**

**Procedure**

**Online-orders:** The password protected Alumni-Forum on the DAAD website [([www.daad-alumni-forum.de](http://www.daad-alumni-forum.de)) Area 'Foren', Forum 'DAAD-Fachliteraturprogramm] enables you to submit direct orders online to the DAAD. However, to be able to do this you need your DAAD personal identification number (PKZ - Persönliche Kennziffer). You benefit by having a user-friendly overview of all available literature, including their price.
