#### Research Grants for Doctoral Candidates and Young Academics and Scientists

- Application deadline for research grants to run for more than six months: 28 August each year
- Application deadlines for research grants to run for up to six months: 28 August each year
- The DAAD will pay an appropriate flat-rate travel allowance.
- Applicants from the Palestinian Territories for research grants must be able to prove that they hold a Master's degree (MA or MSc).
- At the time of application, generally no more than six years should have passed since the graduate gained the last degree; in the case of doctoral students, no more than three years should have passed since starting the doctoral process; and in the case of postdocs, no more than four years should have passed since gaining the doctorate.

#### Research stays for University Academics and Scientists

- Application deadline: 6 November each year
- The DAAD will pay a flat-rate travel allowance of 525 euros for Gaza and 700 euros for Westbank.
- Research stays can start as of 1 June each year at the earliest

#### Study Scholarships for Master's Programmes

- Application deadline: 28 August each year
- Applications are open to candidates already holding an excellent or expected to gain an excellent

Bachelor's degree (BA or BSc) and who would like to gain a Master's degree (MA or MSc), primarily in natural science or engineering subject areas.

- The DAAD will pay an appropriate flat-rate travel allowance.

### **Re-invitation Programme for Former Scholarship Holders**

- Application deadline: 6 November each year
- The DAAD will pay a flat-rate travel allowance of 525 euros for Gaza and 700 euros for Westbank.
- Re-invitations can be commenced on 1 June each year at the earliest.

### **Scholarships for Artists: Study Scholarships**

- Application deadline: 28 August each year
- DAAD will pay an appropriate flat-rate travel allowance.

### **Scholarships for Artists: Study Visits for Academics**

- Application deadline: 16 November each year
- Flat-rate travel allowance: 400.- euros.
- Study visits can be commenced as of 1 June each year at earliest.

### **University Summer Course Grants for Advanced Students**

- Application deadline: 6 November each year
- Flat-rate travel allowance: 400.- euros.

### **"Third country" scholarships**

- Application deadline: 28 August each year
- Applications are open to candidates already holding an excellent or expected to gain an excellent Bachelor's degree (BA or BSc) and who would like to gain a Master's degree (MA or MSc), primarily in natural science or engineering subject areas. Besides the above-mentioned degree, applicants must pass the university entrance exams before the scholarship can be awarded to them. No more than six years must have passed since the applicants gained the BA or BSc degree.

### **Third country scholarships for the Master's programme "German as a Foreign Language" at the German Jordanian University (GJU) in Amman, Jordan**

- Application deadline: 28 August each year.
- Applicants must prove that they hold a Bachelor of Arts degree in German Studies, German as a Foreign Language, or related subjects and philological studies.
- No more than six years should have passed since gaining that degree.
- Language certificate confirming German language skills at TestDaF 3 level (or equivalent) or better.
