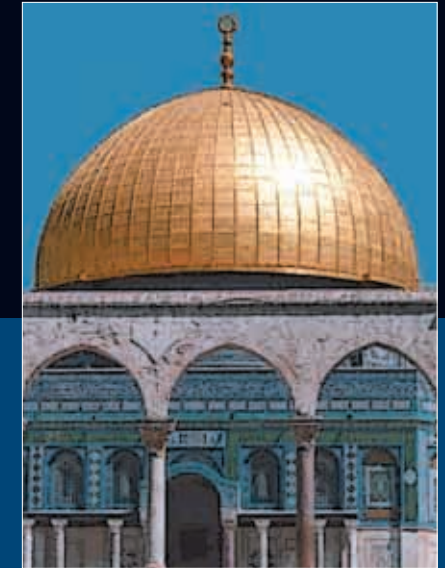

Master's-Scholarships to Germany

- faculty building
- recent graduates (not older than 26)
- minimum average B.A./B. Sc.: 80 %
- TOEFL 550 or above
- admission to an International Degree Program - www.daad.de/idp

Master's-Scholarships to Jordan

- faculty building
- recent graduates (not older than 26)
- minimum average B.A./B.Sc.: 80 %
- TOEFL (500) required for graduation in Jordan
- choice of suitable master-program at UoJ, Amman, JUST or Yarmouk, Irbid

Master's "German as a Foreign Language"

- Master's scholarships for studies at the German-Jordanian University in Amman
- for excellent graduates of German literature, Teaching German as a Foreign Language (DaF), or related fields
- faculty building

Postgraduate Courses for Professionals with Relevance to Developing Countries

- Master's scholarships for young professionals with a minimum of two years working experience
- TOEFL 550 or above required
- leave of absence from place of employment
- applications limited to International Degree Program - www.daad.de/idp - courses with the "double hat" symbol!

PhD-Scholarships to Germany

- faculty building
- excellent grades
- not older than 31 years at time of application
- PhD proposal and letter of acceptance from professor teaching at a German university **or**
- Admission/application to an International Postgraduate Program - www.daad.de/ipp

Short Study & Research Visits to Germany

- for university professors (Ph.D.s)
- grant for up to two months research at a German university
- proposal and letter of invitation from German counterpart

Summer language courses in Germany

- four-week German language course for 2nd or 3rd year university students with prior knowledge of German, especially graduates of high-schools teaching German (with Goethe ZD or DSD)
