A total of 221 students live in group apartments comprised of two to seven rooms, with ten of the rooms being disability-friendly. 1 single appartement is offered to applicants that already live at this residence. The fully equipped kitchen and sanitary facilities are shared. The rooms are approx. 13 sq m in size, and have an Internet, telephone and cable TV connection.

Large 2-bedroom apartments are available for families with children. There is an extra children's room and playground for the children.

### **Rent deposit**

The required deposit is calculated as follows:

- monthly rents up to 300 EUR = 300 EUR deposit
- monthly rents up to 400 EUR = 400 EUR deposit
- monthly rents up to 600 EUR = 600 EUR deposit
- monthly rents up to 800 EUR = 800 EUR deposit

Guests do not pay a deposit, but a key security deposit of 50 EUR is payable as well as a final cleaning charge of 25 EUR if necessary.

### **Duration of housing**

The standard tenancy period is limited to 48 months, in halls with low demand to 60 months.

Tenants can apply for an extension in written form. The application must be filed (at the latest) two months prior to the expiration of the contract.

There is a bar, which is run by the residents themselves. Available for leisure activities are a table tennis room, two music practice rooms (one with a piano), a bike workshop and a barbecue area with outdoor chess.

The number of Service Packages is limited and they will be issued based on the order of the bookings. There are no more Service Packages available for the winter semester 2019/2020.

Two-room apartments are available for families with children. An extra children's room and a playground is provided for the children.

## Standard application procedure

### Application requirements

Admission is granted to German and international students who are enrolled at one of the universities in Hamburg, as well as students attending the Hamburg Conservatorium in Blankenese and a preparatory course at the Studienkolleg (individuals, couples and families).

### Application deadline

Applications can be sent in at the earliest three months before your chosen date for moving in.

## Erasmus or central exchange students

It is strongly recommended to apply for one of the rooms set aside for Erasmus and central exchange students in the student dormitories as it is very difficult to find affordable housing in Hamburg on your own. Please contact your programme coordinator in Hamburg and request a housing application form.

Please note that as an exchange student, you may not apply directly to Studierendenwerk Hamburg for a dorm room. Please also note that the deadline for Erasmus and central exchange student housing offers is approximately three to four months before the semester starts.
