Description/content	<p>Participants will be encouraged to rethink architectural design through a logical and user-oriented rational approach. The goal is to reflect on the intuitive and passionate ideas that allow signature creations.</p> <p>The "Design Thinking" short-term course calls for architectural innovation, describing the process of object creation and exploring the process superimposed on another object/creation (this could range from an urban space, activity or behaviour pattern, or a specific building/structure). The programme shall cover brainstorming design exercises with respect to cross stimulation (fractionation technique for getting ideas moving), suspended judgement (suggestions by participants with no attempt at evaluation of ideas) and the formality of the setting (dividing things into sub-categories and putting them together in new ways).</p>
