It is designed as an undergraduate class, but the variety of students taking this course typically ranges from first-year students to post-graduate students. 	About this course This course explores the intersection of law, society and politics, and it aims to foster discussion of contemporary issues among students from different cultures and disciplines. After an introduction to law and legal culture, we will engage with classical social theorists as well social scientists who examine the impact of law on issues such as morality, crime and punishment, free speech, inequality and private property. Throughout the course, students will be invited to consider 1 – how law simultaneously plays complex constitutive, regulative and coercive roles in society; 2 – that there are both state and non-state legal systems; and 3 – how an individual's place in society affects experiences, values or choices. Students will also develop written and oral communication skills to express informed opinions about issues in law and society as well as intercultural

 $competence\ through\ discussion\ with\ other\ students.$
