2019 Funding requirements

German-Egyptian Progress Partnership Programme Line 1: University partnerships

Living expenses for funded individuals

| • Graduates with a Bachelor's degree | €825 | €65 |
| • Doctoral candidates, academics, lecturers, assistants, etc. (each with a Master's degree or equivalent) | €1,125 | €85 |
| • Academics holding a PhD and professors | €2,000 | €89 |

International health insurance contributions: these must be paid from the lump sum. The importance of adequate insurance coverage must be pointed out to international guests. If it is not possible to take out an international health insurance in the home country, the international participants should be insured by the German host or it should be made sure that they insure themselves promptly after arrival in Germany.

Daily allowance of €10 per person per day of the event (**not for arrival and departure days**): for local participants (persons whose main place of residence is in the city where the event or measure takes place).
