#### The DAAD

The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) is a joint organisation of German institutions of higher education and their student bodies, devoted to internationalising the academic and scientific research system. With the scholarship programmes, the DAAD enables students, researchers and university lecturers to take advantage of the best study and research opportunities available.

It promotes transnational cooperation and university partnerships, and is the German national agency for EU higher education cooperation. The DAAD actively supports Germany's foreign cultural and educational policy goals, national scientific policies and development cooperation efforts. In order to carry out this work, the DAAD maintains a global network of 15 regional offices, 56 information centres and 445 lectureships *(Lektorate)*.



- Promotion of transformation and democratisation processes
- Higher-education cooperative projects in the field of development cooperation
- Intercultural dialogue to surmount lines of conflict
- Implementation of the educational programme Erasmus+ into higher education
- Advice on the implementation of the Bologna Process

- With evaluations, monitoring and reports

### Budget

The DAAD's budget comes largely from federal funds assigned by various ministries, in particular the Federal Foreign Office (AA), the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) and the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ). Further funding comes from the European Union and from businesses, organisations and foreign governments. The DAAD's total budget in 2016 amounted to 500.3 million euros.


