OUTCOMES OF THE COOPERATION

- The construction of a **sustainable network of (mainly) Global South university** researchers collaborating on an investigation of the Literary Cultures of the Global South
- A **better scholarly understanding** of and a further **creative development** of Global-South literary-cultural alliances leading to new research insights and high-profile publications
- The encouragement of **“multilateral” (south-south-north) postgraduate training**
- The establishment of an **internationally visible centre of competence** for the study of Literary Cultures of the Global South based at the University of Tübingen



ACTIVITIES

YEARLY CONFERENCES: Organized at the partner universities with an annual publication as a result

ANNUAL SUMMER SCHOOLS: Will take place in Tübingen for the MA-level students. Workshops will co-taught by members of the participating institutions. Credits will be awarded for the student participation

VISITING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS: For staff members of the participating institutions (from short stays through to six-month research fellowships). These research will result in an annual publication of ‘working papers’

EXCHANGES OF DOCTORAL STUDENTS: Designed to foster a culture of interdisciplinary and international research for doctoral students

‘PUBLIC INTELLECTUALS IN THE GLOBAL SOUTH’: Writers, artists and film-makers will be invited for short residencies in order to publicize their work
