- 634 m € budget and more than 135,000 people funded in DAAD administred programs worldwide in 2021 plus 33,000 Erasmus students
- ...is a self-governing organization of German Universities
- 66 offices worldwide

What does DAAD do?






DAAD provides:

- Scholarships & grants (for <u>all</u> disciplines, at <u>all</u> stages)
- Information and counseling about studying & research in Germany
- Support for internationalization of German universities
- The study of German language and culture abroad



Study Scholarships for Graduates

www.daad.org/gradstudy

- Scholarship to support pursuit of a Master's degree at a German university (up to two years)
- German language ability should be commensurate with needs
- Final-year undergrads may apply
- ~ 70 awarded annually
- € 934/month; health and liability insurance; travel stipend
- Deadline: November 30, 2023





Research Grants

- For graduate students, PhD candidates or postdocs (only short term) with a well-defined research project
- Short term (1-6 months) and Long term (7-12 months)
- Invitation by host institution essential
- Monthly support of € 1,200 for PhD-Students;
 travel stipend; health & liability insurance; grad students € 934
- Deadline: November 3, 2023 (short and long term)
 May 2, 2024 (short term only)





RISE Professional

- Workplace internships of up to six months with leading German companies
- For Master's, PhD students and RISE Germany alumni in Science & Engineering as well as for recent graduates



- German language requirements depend on the nature of the internship
- € 934 or € 1200 monthly stipend plus health insurance, travel stipend, RISE meeting (€500 net. directly from company) or minimum wage
- Web-based matching process (October 15 Nov 30)

RISE Worldwide

- Summer research internships hosted by professor, postdoc or PhD at a Canadian university or research institutes
- For German Bachelor students in the fields of Sciences & Engineering
- German students come with English language abilities
- In Canada, this program is offered in cooperation with Mitacs' Globalink Research Internship program
- Deadline internship providers: September 30







University Summer Course Grant 2024

- Funding for summer courses taught in German at German Universities
- For undergraduate and graduate students
- In principle, applicants must provide proof of a minimum language level of A1.
- Courses must be 3 to 4 weeks in duration
- Focus on literary, cultural, political and economic aspects



NEW! The Gilman-DAAD Germany Scholarship for US students

Who can apply? Undergraduates. Federal Pell Grant holder.

You must be matriculated full-time in an accredited degree program in the U.S and at the completion of the education abroad program.

What can be funded?

Summer or winter short-term course (up to three months) at a German university; Semester or academic year at a German university; Study abroad program through a third-party provider; 6+ week credit-bearing internship



Deadline: October 5, 2023 for programs that start between December 2023-October 2024 and March 7, 2024 for stays from May 1, 2024 to April 30, 2025.
